	materials, master table, analysis output and the completed dissertation during the Viva voce Examination.
	a) Field based Internship in the Cooperative Schools (1 Week) (Marks 50)
	The prospective teacher educators shall observe the teaching and other co-curricular activities of student - teachers both at Level I & II in the co-operative schools and submit their reflective records during the Practical Examination.
	b) Field-based Internship in the Teacher Education Institutions (3 Weeks) (Marks 75)
